

LAND ACQUISITION (POSSESSORY TITLE) ORDINANCE (Chapter 130)

ACQUISITION OF LAND
FOR DEVELOPMENT AT CHA KWO LING VILLAGE, KOWLOON EAST
AND
DEVELOPMENT AT EX-CHA KWO LING KAOLIN MINE SITE (PHASE 2)
(Notice under section 4)

To every person on whom notice shall be served under section 4(1)(a) of the Land Acquisition (Possessory Title) Ordinance in respect of the land situate in Kowloon comprising (i) areas of approximately 29.8 square metres shown coloured red on Plan No. KM10930 (for development at Cha Kwo Ling Village, Kowloon East) and (ii) areas of approximately 92.7 square metres shown coloured red on Plan No. KM9399 (for development at Ex-Cha Kwo Ling Kaolin Mine Site (Phase 2)), such areas of land being hereinafter referred to as 'the land'.

TAKE NOTICE that the Chief Executive in Council decided that the acquisition of the land is required for a public purpose, I under section 3(1) of the Land Acquisition (Possessory Title) Ordinance on 9 May 2023 made an acquisition order for the acquisition of the land, which order together with the said Plan No. KM10930 and Plan No. KM9399 described above may be inspected by members of the public free of charge at the following offices and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—

This notice was affixed on the land on 18 May 2023.

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED that upon the expiration of THREE MONTHS from the date of the affixing of the notice on the land at midnight on 18 August 2023, the land shall by virtue of section 5 of the Land Acquisition (Possessory Title) Ordinance vest in the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and that every interest, right or easement of any person in or over the land shall be extinguished. The date of vesting shall be 19 August 2023.

Every person making a claim of ownership to the land or to any part thereof, or claiming any interest, right or easement in or over it, shall, in accordance with section 6(1) of the Land Acquisition (Possessory Title) Ordinance, submit to the Director of Lands a written notice of his claim together with such evidence as he may possess to substantiate it, before the date of vesting as mentioned above or within such further period, if any, as the Director of Lands may permit.

Personal Information Collection Statement

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Director of Lands in connection with any written claims served under section 6(1) of the Land Acquisition (Possessory Title) Ordinance (Chapter 130) will be used for the processing of the claims and other related purposes. The provision of the information, including the personal data, as required under section 6(1) of the Land Acquisition (Possessory Title) Ordinance (Chapter 130) is obligatory. If such information, including the personal data, as required under section 6(1) of the Land Acquisition (Possessory Title) Ordinance (Chapter 130) is not provided as requested, the claims may be rejected. Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other organizations or agencies which are required to handle the claims and related matters. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data held by us.
