TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics has ordered under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to close temporarily sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, central medians/traffic islands, pedestrian crossing and amenity areas within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 60102100/GAZ/S5/1.1 and 60102100/ GAZ/S5/1.2 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, and as amended by Amendment Plans Nos. 60102100/GAZ/S5/1.1A, 60102100/GAZ/S5/1.2A and 60102100/GAZ/ S5/1.3 ('the Amendment Plans') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto. The Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 2235 published on 17 April 2014 and 25 April 2014. The Amendment Plans and amendment scheme were referred to in G.N. 8325 published on 2 November 2018 and 9 November 2018. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that from 17 October 2023 to 16 October 2024, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, central medians/traffic islands, pedestrian crossing and amenity areas to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve construction of carriageways, footpaths, subway, central medians/traffic islands and pedestrian crossings, as well as other ancillary works.
