

ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)  
(Notice under section 18)

ROAD WORKS UNDER PWP ITEM NO. B820CL  
SITE FORMATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE WORKS FOR PUBLIC HOUSING  
DEVELOPMENT NEAR TAN KWAI TSUEN, YUEN LONG

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics has ordered under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance') to close permanently sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle track and central medians/traffic islands; and to close temporarily sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths/tracks, central medians/traffic islands and cycle track within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 199086/B&V/GP/101 to 103 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, and as modified by Modification Plan No. MP-01 ('the Modification Plan'). The Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 4280 published on 16 July 2021 and 23 July 2021. The Modification Plan was referred to in G.N. 2004 published on 29 April 2022 and 6 May 2022. The Permanent Secretary for Transport and Logistics has further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Ordinance that as from 20 October 2023, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle track and central medians/traffic islands to be permanently closed, shall be extinguished; and from 20 October 2023 to 19 October 2024, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over the sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths/tracks, central medians/traffic islands and cycle track to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during that period.

The works to be carried out in association with this closure mainly involve the construction of at-grade carriageways and elevated carriageways for two-lane two-way traffic, at-grade footpaths, elevated footpaths, roundabouts, central medians/traffic islands, amenity areas, pedestrian crossings, signal-controlled pedestrian crossings, run-ins/run-outs, lifts, lift tower with associated staircase and a public transport interchange, as well as other ancillary works.

This notice will be affixed on or near the affected carriageways, footpaths/tracks, cycle tracks and central medians/traffic islands on 20 October 2023.

Any person having a compensatable interest under the Ordinance may serve upon the Secretary for Transport and Logistics a written claim, which can be submitted *via* one of the following means, before the expiration of one year from the date of closure, extinction, modification or restriction:—
