## SEWERAGE WORKS UNDER PWP ITEM NO. B820CL SITE FORMATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE WORKS FOR PUBLIC HOUSING DEVELOPMENT NEAR TAN KWAI TSUEN, YUEN LONG

(Notice under section 18 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation) (Chapter 358AL)

TAKE NOTICE that under powers delegated by the Chief Executive, I have made an order under section 17(1)(a) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358AL), to close temporarily of the existing carriageways, footpaths/tracks, open spaces, cycle tracks, verges, central medians/traffic islands, pedestrian crossings, lay-bys and run-ins/run-outs, or parts thereof, within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 199086/B&V/GP/001 to 004 (the 'Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto. The Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N. 4279 published on 16 July 2021 and 23 July 2021. I have further declared under section 17(1)(c) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358 AL) that from 20 October 2023 to 19 October 2024, all public or private rights in, upon, under or over sections of the above existing carriageways, footpaths/tracks, open spaces, cycle tracks, verges, central medians/traffic islands, pedestrian crossings, lay-bys and run-ins/run-outs, or parts thereof to be temporarily closed, shall be extinguished, modified or restricted, as the case may be, during the period.

The sewerage works to be carried out on the above affected existing carriageways, footpaths/ tracks, cycle tracks, open spaces, verges, central medians/traffic islands, pedestrian crossings, lay-bys and run-ins/run-outs, or parts thereof mainly involve:—

- (i) construction of about 4 600 metres of gravity sewers and associated manholes within the limit of the works area as shown on the Plans; and
- (ii) ancillary works including reinstatement of carriageways, footpaths/tracks, open spaces, cycle tracks, verges, central medians/traffic islands, pedestrian crossings, lay-bys and run-ins/run-outs.

A copy of the order and the Plans showing the above affected existing carriageways, footpaths/ tracks, open spaces, cycle tracks, verges, central medians/traffic islands, pedestrian crossings, lay-bys and run-ins/run-outs, or parts thereof may be inspected by members of the public, free of charge, at the following locations and during the following hours when those offices are normally open to the public:—
