- (i) to provide land for the developments at San Hing Road and Hong Po Road, Tuen Mun. Site formation works will be carried out within the resumption/clearance limit as shown on the Resumption Plan ('the Project Area') including the area as shown coloured orange on the Resumption Plan. The formed lands will accommodate public housing developments, associated educational, sports and recreational facilities, as well as other associated engineering works for supporting the developments at San Hing Road and Hong Po Road;
- (ii) for the purposes of, or incidental to works and use of roads proposed or to be proposed under the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) in the Project Area; and
- (iii) for the purposes of, or incidental to works proposed or to be proposed under the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358, Subsidiary Legislation AL) in the Project Area.

The written objection must sufficiently identify the objector as an owner or occupier of the Land or a person having a right in relation to the Land and describe the manner in which the objector alleges he will be affected by the Proposal. An objection (i) that is not made by an owner or occupier of the Land or a person having a right in relation to the Land or (ii) that fails to sufficiently identify the objector as an owner or occupier of the Land or a person having a right in relation to the Land or to describe the manner in which the objector alleges he will be affected by the Proposal is invalid and treated as not having been made for the purposes of section 2G of the Lands Resumption Ordinance (Chapter 124). An objection that makes on a ground relating to any compensation (whether monetary or non-monetary) or any financial or other assistance in connection with the Proposal is, to the extent that it is made on that ground, invalid and treated as not having been made for the purposes of section 2G of the Lands Resumption Ordinance (Chapter 124). Objectors are requested to provide their address, electronic mail address or fax number so that a reply may be given to them.

Personal Information Collection Statement

Any information, including any personal data, submitted to the Director of Lands in connection with any written objections made under section 2B of the Lands Resumption Ordinance (Chapter 124) will be used for processing the objections and other purposes directly related to the processing of the objections. The provision of any information, which may include any personal data, as required to be provided under section 2B(2) of the Lands Resumption Ordinance (Chapter 124) is obligatory. If such information, including any personal data, as required to be provided under section 2B(2) of the Lands Resumption Ordinance (Chapter 124) is not provided, the objection is invalid and treated as not having been made for the purposes of section 2G according to section 2B(3) of the Lands Resumption Ordinance (Chapter 124). The provision of any information, including any personal data, other than the information required to be provided under section 2B(2) of the Lands Resumption Ordinance (Chapter 124) is voluntary. However, it may not be possible to further process the objections if such information, including the personal data, is not sufficiently provided. Any information, including the personal data is usubmitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other persons, organizations or agencies to handle the objections and matters directly related to the handling of the objections. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data.
